Student Organization Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recognized by the SORC as a registered student organization ● Supports a large undergraduate constituency ● Holds a mission that is primarily non-political ● Promotes inclusion and belonging ● Contributes to the Pitt community
Student Organization Impact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Executes diverse, expansive programming ● Advocates and advances community interests ● Demonstrates commitment to executing purpose
Student Organization Engagement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Commits to engaging members on a large scale ● Establishes an organized approach to communicating with members (i.e. meetings, events, programs, etc.) ● Promotes outreach and collaboration with other student organizations
Student Organization History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Demonstrates history of programmatic success ● Proves history of fundraising and financing ● Indicates history as an active member of the Pitt community
Student Organization Goals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Shows clear goals to expand execution of organizational purpose and impact ● Demonstrates support from engaged and connected Staff advisor ● Indicates need for remuneration support
Remunerated Role Details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Supports the organization in a critical way ● Demands a time commitment that limits other paid opportunities ● Engages supported constituency
